## **Terms of Participation in the Conference**

To include a paper in the conference program and the collection of abstracts, it is necessary to submit to the Organizing Committee via the <u>electronic registration form</u> no later than September 30, 2025:

- ✓ participant's application form;
- ✓ abstract of the paper and/or full article.
- \* If there are two or more authors, the paper should be registered by only one of the authors.

#### **Requirements for abstracts:**

- ✓ please submit the text document in \*.doc or \*.rtf format;
- ✓ papers are accepted in Ukrainian and English;
- ✓ the total length of the abstract in A4 format must not exceed 3 pages, including all figures, tables, and references;
- ✓ margins: 2.0 cm, Times New Roman, font size 14, single spacing;
- ✓ text must be justified (aligned on both sides) without hyphenation;
- ✓ all non-text elements must be created using Word built-in tools;
- ✓ figures, diagrams, formulas, and tables must fit within the page margins;
- ✓ figures, diagrams, formulas, and tables must be separated from the main text by one empty line above and below;
- ✓ pages should not be numbered;
- ✓ file names should contain the surname of the first co-author in English (e.g., Petrenko.tezy.doc, Petrenko.stat.doc).
